Used Antifreeze

Accepted by most automotive service
centers. Call first to verify limitations
with automotive service center.

Used Oils/Fluids

Motor oil, transmission oil, diesel oil,
vegetable cooking oil, and hydraulic fluid
are all accepted at the Fruitland
Township Ecology Station.

Aerosol Paints

Empty cans may be discarded in regular
trash.



Paint

Kitty litter may be added to paint in order
to dry it. After the paint is dry, it can be
placed in regular trash. Many schools
will accept paint as a donation for school
projects. Contact the school first to
verify any limitations.

Batteries

Automobile batteries may be returned to
auto parts retail stores and repair centers.
Call first to verify limitations with auto
parts retailer.

Hearing aid batteries may sometimes be
recycled where they were purchased.
Otherwise they may be taken as part of
the Muskegon County Hazardous Waste
Collection Program.

Nickel-Cadmium batteries (rechargeable
batteries, such as video camera batteries)
can be recycled at some Radio Shack
locations. Call first to verify limitations
with Radio Shack.
