

**ARTICLE 21**

**SECTION R 21.01 NESTROM ROAD PARK ORDINANCE**

**SECTION R 21.02 INTENT**

An ordinance to regulate activities in Nestrom Road Park, including the parking of vehicles.

THE TOWNSHIP OF FRUITLAND, MUSKEGON COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

A new ordinance entitled Nestrom Road Park Ordinance is adopted and shall read as follows:

**SECTION R 21.03 HOURS OF OPERATION**

The hours of operation for the Nestrom Road Park (“Park”) shall be from one hour before dawn to one hour after dusk. The only exceptions to the hours of operation shall be events approved by the Fruitland Township Board, including approved activities taking place in and around the Fruitland Township Hall.

**SECTION R 21.04 PARKING REGULATIONS**

During the months of April through October, parking is only permitted in designated locations in the Park. During the months of November through March, parking in the Park is only permitted within the marked parking spaces in the parking area adjacent to the Fruitland Township Hall.

**SECTION R 21.05 PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**

- A. Alcoholic beverages.
- B. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
- C. Hunting, shooting, archery or golfing activities.
- D. Loud noises that may disturb neighbors.
- E. Littering.
- F. Fires, except in grills.
- G. Motorized vehicles may be operated off the paved roads, except snowmobiles.

**SECTION R 21.06 PENALTIES**

Any person that shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction of such violation, be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100, or by imprisonment in Muskegon County jail for a period not to exceed 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

**SECTION R 21.07 EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.
